Pomegranate Tree

- Pomegranates grow on trees (actually they are technically shrubs, but are often pruned to tree form)
- Pomegranate trees have oblong, lance-shaped, smooth and glossy leaves
- The tree also has thorns!
- When blooming, the flowers are red, pink or orange

Date Palm

- Dates grow on trees
- The date palm grows about 75 feet tall!
- Date palms have about 16 feet long leaves that are paired opposite each other on the stem.
- The date is a one-seeded fruit
- More than 1,000 dates may appear on a single bunch that can weigh 18 pounds or more!

Olive Tree

- Olives grow on trees (or shrubs)
- The olive tree doesn't usually grow taller than 25-50 feet in height.
- Olive tree leaves are silver green and oblong.
- Olive tree trunks are usually gnarled and twisted
- When in bloom, the flowers are small and white

Fig Tree

- Figs grow on trees (or shrubs)
- Fig trees are small, 23-33 feet tall, and deciduous
- Fig tree trunks have smooth white bark
- Fig trees have large leaves and the fruit is tear-shaped

Wheat

- Wheat is a grass
- It is a bunch grass
- Wheat leaves emerge from the shoot in an upright direction
- The leaves are smooth near the base but rough near the tip on the upper side
- The leaf sheaf may be smooth or hairy

Barley

- Barley is a grass
- Barley has few leaves, which alternate
- Barley is lighter than wheat
- Barley has long, smooth and sharp projections that shoot out from its base and tend to overlap

Grapes

- Grapes grow on deciduous vines
- Grapes grow in clusters of 15 to 300
- Grapes can be red, black, dark blue, yellow, green, orange and pink
